<i>September 1, 1959</i>	“Sandy Koufax fans 18 for record; Wally Moon’s homer beats Giants in 9th, 5-2”
<i>October 9, 1959</i>	“Dodgers fly home in triumph today; L.A. reception awaits World Series winners”
<i>April 10, 1962</i>	“At last...it’s play ball in Chavez Ravine today; Full house for Dodger, Red opener”
<i>October 3, 1963</i>	“Sandy sizzles, Bombers fizzle, 5-2! Koufax fans record 15 in World Series game 1”
<i>October 4, 1963</i>	“Podres cracks whip, Yanks jump, 4-1; It’s two down, two to go”
<i>October 6, 1963</i>	“Big D cuts off Yank power again, 1-0; Dodgers have champs on ropes”
<i>October 7, 1963</i>	“Dodgers sweep Series in four as Yankees fall flat on pin stripes, 2-1”
<i>October 3, 1965</i>	“It’s all over! The Dodger way: 2 hits + Sandy = flag”
<i>October 10, 1965</i>	“Home sweet home...Dodgers win 4-0 in World Series game 3”

- October 20, 1981* “Now Fernandomania goes to Broadway; Dodgers win NL pennant”
- October 24, 1981* “Fernando staggers, but Yankees finally fall; Dodgers win 5-4”
- October 25, 1981* “Dodgers win 8-7, and tie the Series 2-2”
- October 26, 1981* “Guerrero and Yeager bomb the Bombers; Dodgers take their win streak to Bronx”
- October 29, 1981* “Dodgers rout N.Y., win World Series; Comeback trail led to 4th title”
- October 1, 1983* “Dodgers celebrate NL West title by beating Giants, 4-3”
- October 3, 1985* “Dodgers win the West – then the game; Title comes in 5th inning, and the rest is easy”
- September 27, 1988* “Dodgers uncork NL West title”
- October 13, 1988* “Orel retort silences Mets, 6-0; Hershiser’s 5-hitter gives L.A. a World Series ticket”
- October 16, 1988* “Gibson’s shot in the dark stuns A’s; Dodgers win game 1, 5-4”
- October 17, 1988* “A’s have nothing on 2-0 Dodgers”
- October 20, 1988* “Howell gets A’s on his makeup test; Dodgers lead Series 3-1”
- October 21, 1988* “A title out of the blue; Hershiser’s 4-hitter lifts Dodgers to clincher over A’s, 5-2”
- June 5, 1990* “Ramon Martinez strikes out 18, ties Koufax”
