History of The Chicago Cubs

- September 23, 1907* “Cubs’ hundredth victory; By dividing double-header with Boston they cinch Pennant”
- September 24, 1907* “Chicago cinches Pennant; Scores 101st victory by defeating Philadelphia, 4 to 1”
- October 9, 1907* “Tigers and Cubs tie; Darkness ends brilliant 12-inning contest in Chicago”
- October 10, 1907* “Chicago wins, 3 to 1; Brilliant playing and good luck joint factors in their triumph”
- October 11, 1907* “Chicago wins again; Cubs outclass Tigers, scoring 5 runs to Detroit’s 1”
- October 12, 1907* “Chicago wins third; Opportune hitting brings defeat to the Tigers, 6 to 1”
- October 13, 1907* “Chicago Cubs win World’s Championship from Detroit Tigers”
- October 9, 1908* “Cubs win Pennant; Score enough runs in one inning to beat New York”
- October 11, 1908* “Cubs win first from Tigers, 10 runs to 6”
- October 12, 1908* “Cubs win again; Six runs to one”
- October 13, 1908* “Tigers turned tables on Cubs”
- October 14, 1908* “Cubs shut out the Tigers, 3-0”
- October 15, 1908* “Cubs again are the Champions; Score fourth victory by shutting out Tigers, 2-0”
- October 3, 1910* “Cubs now Champions; Clinch Pennant in National League by beating Reds”
- October 23, 1910* “Cubs’ 4 to 3 victory raises Chicago hopes”
- October 24, 1910* “Athletics are now World’s Champions; Vanquish Cubs by score of 7 to 2 in fifth game”
- August 26, 1918* “Cubs clinch Pennant by beating Dodgers”
- September 7, 1918* “Killifer hits a double that nets Cubs 3-1 win after teammates clear his eye”
- September 11, 1918* “Vaughn shuts out Red Sox to keep Cubs in running”
